

Sammamish Chinese School Code of Conduct and Rules

Drop Off & Pick-up	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All students must be dropped off and picked up on time. 2. Notice needs to be given in advance if a student will be late for class or absent. 3. There will be a \$5 late fee for up to 15 minutes after your scheduled pick-up time and \$1 per minute thereafter.
Driving in & out of Parking Lot	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parents are expected to use parking stalls when dropping off and picking up their child(ren), not stopping in the middle of the parking lot and thereby stalling traffic. 2. Parents are expected not to park in the clearly marked "Fire Lane" in front of the Administration building, even when waiting for their child(ren). 3. Parents are expected to drive solely through the parking lot.
Be a Responsible Student	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are expected not to touch or disrupt any of the belongings of the Church. 2. Parents are expected to pay for any item(whether it belongs to SCS or SHLC) that their child(ren) damages or breaks. 3. Students are expected to respect all teachers and schoolmates at all times. 4. Students are expected to always follow the teacher's instructions and school rules.
Classroom Behavior	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are expected to pay close attention to the teachers in class. 2. Students are expected to raise their hands and wait to be called on before talking in class. 3. Students are expected to bring a backpack, textbook, and all other necessary materials (sharpened pencils, erasers, etc.) to class. 4. Students are not allowed to bring any toys (including all trading cards and electronic toys) to SCS. 5. No gum and colored drink are allowed in class and in Chinese School.
Recess Times	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students are expected not to run in the hallway. 2. When outside on the playground with supervising of teacher or presents, students are expected not to step on any flowerbeds, and not to hang or sit on the railing. 3. Students are expected not to go beyond the boundaries of the play area. 4. Students are expected to play safely and not to engage in unsafe activities.

I understand that if I break any of the above-mentioned rules, the teacher in charge may enforce an appropriate consequence.
